

Application for Appraiser

The Seneca County Sheriff's Office will be accepting applications for qualified individuals to perform appraisals on properties subject to Sheriff's Sale. Per Section 2329.17 of the Ohio Revised Code, individuals performing appraisals on said properties are required to be disinterested property owners and residents of Seneca County. Selected individuals shall be administered an oath impartially to appraise the property upon actual view, and return a written estimate of the real value of the property. In accordance with Section 311.19 of the Ohio Revised Code, individuals performing appraisals as directed by the Sheriff, shall be allowed a fee for their services as the court directs.

Interested applicants should submit to the Seneca County Sheriff's office their full name, telephone number and residential address within Seneca County. In addition, if your current residence is not owned by you, please include the address of other property held by you within the county. Applicant information should be received prior to Friday, February 24th, 2012. Selected individuals will be notified no later than Friday, March 9, 2012.
